EQUALITY of status and of opportunity;


and to promote among them all

PROGRAMME ON EFFECTIVE DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION

Recognizing the role of District Judges and Chief Judicial Magistrates in Judicial Administration of Justice, the Academy has proposed to have Special Programmes on

Effective District Administration and Court Management on

The topics include presentations by Hon'ble Supreme Court Judges and High Court Judges on
