Subj: Public Services - Madras Last Grade Service - Peons  
in the Criminal Judicial Department - Duty of  
guarding the residences of Magistrates at nights -  
Instructions - Issued.

The High Court Considers it essential that Magistrates should have the services of a peon readily available during nights especially as they are likely to be called out at nights for purposes of recording dying declarations and they also usually take the official records with them for purposes of perusal during nights or for writing out judgments. The High Court, therefore, directs that the peons of the Magistrates' Courts should be required to take bed by turns in the residences of the Magistrates so as to be ready to attend to any urgent item of work that may arise and also to guard the residences of Magistrates at nights.
