Sub: Instructions to ensure that the amount in respect of Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal Cases, deposited by the Insurance Companies are property invested in the Matimalised Banks - Issued - Regarding.

It has been brought to the notice of the High Court that in espect of Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal Cases, the amount exposited by the Insurance Companies are not properly invested in the Nationalised Banks by the administrative staff, as ter the Unicial Orders passed by the Tribunals.

It has been further brought to the notice of the High Court that on matuirity, all the amounts deposited are recalled to the caust deposit but they are not reinvested, causing thereby heavy has to the claimants. On referring the complaints to the Principal pastrict Judges, it has been reported by them that actions have an taken against the erring staff concerned, who are ultimately evarued minor punishments but the end result is that the claimants denied of their due share.

All the Judicial Officers dealing with Motors Accident Claims directed to see that there are no lapses on the part of investment of the amounts awarded. While investing the mount in respect of minors, it should be invested in such a way that it gets matured only at the time of the minor becomes major under re-investment schemes, so that no time gap is there in cruing the interest on the invested amount.

Any lapse on the part of investing the amount in to the seak on deposit by the Insurance Company will be viewed seriously be presiding Officers should see that the amounts are invested plantly and if there we are any lapses on the part of Ministerial wifthen the amount of loss should be recovered from the staff excepted and the claimants must be made good, instead of issuing traing or censure to the staff by the act of which the claimant and going to be benefitted.

All the Motors Accidents Claims Tribunal Judicial Officers thereby directed to bestow their personal attention in the matter
