ORDER:

The Government have examined the question of providing Police guard to all Judicial Officers in consultation with the Director General of Police, Madras and the High Court, Madras. It has been considered that to ensure the safety and security of the Judicial Officers, it will be adequate that the police station in whose jurisdiction they reside, provide surveillance during night in such areas and that the Judicial Officers may be provided with patta books in which the police men on beat duty may be asked to sign in order to ensure that adequate number of visits has been made.

2. The Government direct that the the police station in jurisdiction the judicial Officers reside should provide surveillance during the night in such areas and that the Judicial Officers be provided with patta books in which the police men on beat duty be asked to sign with a view to ensuring the security of the Judicial Officers.

3. The Director General of Police, Madras is requested to issue suitable instructions to the subordinate Officers concerned in this regard.
