I am directed to refer to your D.O.Letter cited in which guidelines of the Government in respect of sanction of Concurrent Charge Allowance, LTC/HTC, Soft loans for purchase of vehicles / Personal Computers etc. Transfer Grant / Disturbance allowance has been requested.

2. In respect of Concurrent Charge Allowance, an amendment to G.O.Ms.No. 985, Home, Dated: 16.10.2006 has been issued vide G.O.Ms.No.1538, Home, Dated: 12.11.2008

3. In respect of LTC/HTC, the existing guidelines in leave Travel Concession Rules applicable to the Government Servants as provided in State are applicable to the Judicial Officers also in addition to the orders issued in G.O.Ms.No. 985, Home, Dated: 16.10.2006.



As regards the Transfer Grant/Disturbance Allowance to Judicial Officers, the Rules and guidelines available in TTA Rules applicable to the Government Servants in the State are also applicable to the Judicial Officers in addition to the orders issued in G.O.Ms.No. 985, Home, Dated: 16.10.2006.

5. As regards the soft loans viz., advance for purchasing of vehicles, personal computers etc., the existing guidelines/orders/rules in force applicable to the Government Servants in the State are also applicable to the Judicial Officers.

6. The issue of extending the concurrent charge allowance to the judicial officers of the Pudhuchery Judicial service, who are on deputation in Tamil Nadu, will be examined separately.

ORDER:

The following amendment is issued to G.O.Ms.No. 985, Home (Cts.IA) Department, Dated: 16.10.2006.

AMENDMENT

For Item 'Concurrent Charge Allowance' under paragraph 2 of the Government Order, the following shall be substituted;

CONCURRENT CHARGE ALLOWANCE

The Government sanction the Concurrent Charge Allowance to the Judicial officers when they are placed in charge of another court continuously beyond the period of ten working days and if they perform appreciable judicial work of that court, the charge allowance be paid to such Judicial officer at 10% of the minimum of the time scale of the additional post held. The other guidelines provided in Rule 49 of F.R. shall be applicable to the Judicial Officers.
