OFFICIAL MEMORANDUM

Sub: Public Services - Government Servants joining Correspondence Courses for acquiring additional qualification - Delegation of power to Heads of Offices - Orders - Issued.

- Read: 1. G.O.Ms.328, P & A.R.(Per-A) Department, dated 9.4.83.
2. Govt.Lr.No.22536/84-1, P & A.R.(Per-A) Department, dated 22.9.84.

The undermentioned Officers are informed that the Government in their order first cited have ordered that a Government servant who joins the Correspondence Courses conducted by various Universities should obtain prior permission of the head of the Department concerned. Subsequently the Government in their letter second cited (copy enclosed) have informed that the power to grant permission to Government servants to join correspondence courses, now vested with the Heads of the Departments, may be delegated to the Heads of offices and the Heads of Offices shall be instructed to ensure that the grant of such permission to the staff will be without detriment to the normal functioning of the offices concerned.

After careful consideration, High Court, Madras delegates the power to the Heads of Offices in the Judicial Department to grant permission to Government Servants under their control to join correspondence courses conducted by various universities and they are also required to ensure that the grant of such permission will be without detriment to the normal functioning of the offices concerned.
