The Hon'ble High Court, after carefully considering the proposal made by the Director of Forensic Sciences Department, to the Government, in furtherance of one of the recommendations of Tamil Nadu Police Commission (Third) has directed that the following instructions shall be issued to the Judicial Officers in Tamil Nadu:

· All the Judicial Officers are hereby directed that they shall report the results of those cases, in which the services of the Forensic Sciences Department are availed, immediately either to the Director, Forensic Sciences Department, Chennai or to the respective Assistant Directors of that Department viz., at Coimbatore, Madurai, Ramanathapuram, Salem, Thanjavur, Trichy, Tirunelveli and Vellore, as the case may be.

The Judicial Officers shall mark a copy of the Judgment, without fail, to these Laboratories for follow up action to review the usefulness of the reports and to improve the method or the quality of chemical analysis or to modify the reporting pattern wherever necessary.

The above said instructions shall be observed by the Sessions Judges/Assistant Sessions Judges/Judicial Magistrates concerned strictly, in accordance with Rule 347 of Criminal Rules of Practice and Circular Order 1958, without any deviation. Such deviation, if any, would be viewed very seriously.
