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JUL 2010 Sub: High Court, Madras - Subordinate Courts - Steps to reduce the pendency of cases - Certain directions, to be issued to the Judicial Officers in Subordinate Judiciary -Ordered - Communicated - Reg.

As directed, the following directions are issued for reducing the pendency of arrears in the Subordinate Courts:

- District Judges are directed to prepare list of cases, subject / nature (i) wise, pending in each court of their respective District and to forward the same to the High Court, within a period of 30 days.
- The District Judges and the Judges of individual courts are directed to ensure that such list is prepared of all the cases pending in their respective courts.
- The Chart shall be prepared, court-wise, giving details of SLNo., subject / nature, Case no./year, name of the parties, status of the case, action taken, date / year of pendency and next date as fixed by the court.

The above said directions are to be complied with, strictly and deviation thereof, will be viewed seriously.
