The Administrative Reforms Committee constituted under the Chairmanship of Dr. Justice A.K. Rajan, Retired Judge, of Madras High Court, has recommended that staff movement should be strictly monitored and the Movement Register shall be maintained and checked by the Head of Office every day.

2. Movement Register for monitoring Staff Movement is already in vogue in all Government Offices. Consequent to the recommendations of the above Committee, Government has decided to accept the recommendation and to reiterate the maintenance of the Staff Movement Register in every Government Office.

3. Therefore, all the Departments of Secretariat and the Heads of the Departments are requested to maintain the Staff Movement Registers promptly. The Heads of the Departments are requested to instruct all the Sub-ordinate offices under their control to maintain the Staff Movement Register for monitoring the Staff Movement during office hours strictly.
