Subj: - Judicial Officers - attending to Judicial work in Chambers - instructions - issued.

1. It has come to the notice of the High Court that of late some District Munsifs and Judl. Magistrates do not attend the public court in the after noon and choose to pass orders on applications for interim injunctions, petitions for appointment of commissioners, bail applications and petitions under Section 317 Cr. P.C. in the chambers only. Some Judicial Magistrates invariably sit in their chambers and dispose of cases in which accused admit the offence. The High Court deprecates this practice and views it with displeasure.

2. All the Presiding Officers are directed ~~not~~ to pass any Judicial order in their chambers. Any violation of this instruction will be viewed seriously in future.
