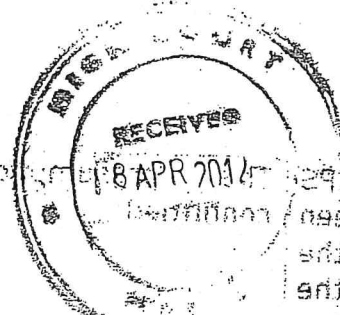

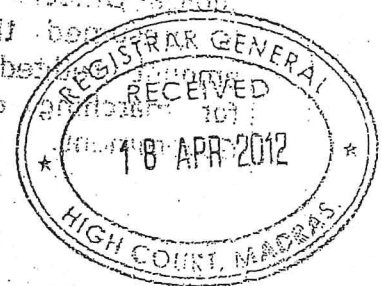

| 1. | It is presumed that 40% of the salary arrears in respect of Judicial Officers credited to GPF/CPS on 19/07/2010, earns Interest from 07/2010. | The presumption is confirmed. |

| 2. | It is presumed that in case of CPS account holders net arrears has been arrived at only after deducting the mandatory 10% contribution on the difference in pay owing to revision. | The presumption is confirmed. |
| 3. | Crediting 40% of arrears in respect of Judicial Officers to the CPS Account. It is presumed that the 40% arrear amount credited to CPS is not eligible for matching contribution from the Government. | Crediting of pay commission arrears to the CPS Account is based on policy decision of Government. As it is not mandatory contribution to be made by the subscriber, matching Government contribution does not arise. The presumption is confirmed. |
| 4. | Whether arrear amount will be exhibited separately in the CPS/GPF Account of Judicial Officers. | It shall be exhibited separately. |
| 5. | It is presumed that the arrear amount credited to the GPF/CPS may be paid to the officers in the event of Retirement / Death. | It will be paid at the time of the Retirement/ Death |
| 6. | It is presumed that allowing the drawal of arrears of transfer grant already drawn and adjusted in the TTA Bill is not correct. | The presumption is confirmed. |
| 7. | It is presumed that no arrears of additional charge allowance shall be paid in pursuance of subsequent orders of increase in pay with retrospective effect. | The presumption is confirmed. |
| 8. | It is presumed that drawal of arrears of Robe allowance due to increase in pay is not permissible. | The presumption is confirmed. |
| 9. | It is presumed that drawal of arrears of Fuel allowance already available by the Judicial Officer is not correct. | The presumption is confirmed. |
