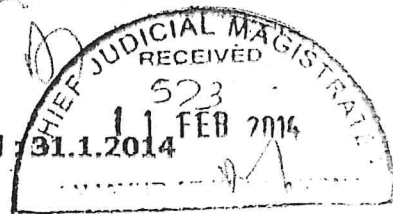

I am to forward herewith a photocopy of the certified copy of the Judgment dated 20.1.2014, passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, in Criminal Appeal No.259/2009 and to state that the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, while passing the order observed as follows :

" Having noticed that, in several cases where poisoning is suspected, the prosecuting agencies are not taking steps to obtain viscera report, we feel it necessary to issue certain directions in that behalf. We direct that in cases where poisoning is suspected, immediately after the post-mortem, the viscera should be sent to the FSL. The prosecuting agencies should ensure that the viscera is, in fact, sent to the FSL for examination and the FSL should ensure that the viscera is examined immediately and report is sent to the investigating agencies / courts post haste. If the viscera report is not received, the concerned court must ask for explanation and must summon the concerned officer of the FSL to give an explanation as to why the viscera report is not forwarded to the investigating agency / court. The criminal court must ensure that it is brought on record"
