Orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Avtar Singh and Ref: others Vs. State of Madhya Pradesh [1982(1) SCC 438) HANJAVUR AT MURAKON

Attention of all the Principal District Judges/District Judges in the State of Tamil Nadu and Union Territory of Puducherry is drawn to the observations of the Hon'ble Apex Court in Avtar Singh and others Vs. State of Madhya Pradesh reported in 1982(1) SCC.438, wherein the Hon'ble Supreme Court has called for making Rules as part of Criminal Manuals u/s.477(1) Cr.P.C., enabling the accused to sit down, during the trial.

Since, such Rules are to be framed, in the meantime, all the Judicial Officers, dealing with criminal cases in the State of Tamil Nadu and Union of Territory of Puducherry are hereby directed to comply with the directions issued by the Hon'ble Apex Court in the abovesaid judgment, in letter and spirit and ensure that accused appearing before criminal courts in their respective jurisdiction are allowed to sit during the trial.
