

Sir,

Sub: Courts and Judges - Implementation of Shetty Commission Recommendation - Medical facilities to Judicial Officers - Clarification - Furnishing of -Regarding.

Ref: Your letter No.PAO(HC)/BASI/UNIT-II/2013/1028, dated 21.03.2013.

I am directed to invite attention to your letter cited and to state that the Judicial Officers are entitled to claim reimbursement of the medical expenses incurred by them or for their family members for the medical attendance and treatment undergone by them both as out-patient or in-patient in any hospital or dispensary as per G.O.Ms.No. 985, Home, dated 16.10.06. There should not be any restriction on reimbursement except to the extent of in-patient room entitlement. Further, there should not be any ceiling on reimbursement of expenditure on expensive treatments like kidney transplant, open heart surgery etc.,

2. I am therefore to state that the Government have examined the request of the Pay and Accounts Officer, High Court, Chennai in detail and issue the following clarification:-
