Sub: Judicial Department - Tamil Nadu Basic Service Association - Resolutions - Utilisation of Office Assistants at the residence of Judicial Officers - Instructions - Issued - Reg.

Ref: Resolutions passed by Judicial Office Assistants Association, Cuddalore and Judicial Basic Government Employee's Association, Tiruchirappalli.

The Judicial Basic Service Association, Cuddalore and Tiruchirappalli have passed resolutions regarding certain grievances of the Office Assistants in Judicial Department and also requested for fixing up of norms for the Office Assistants.

The High Court, called for the views of the District Judges/Chief Judicial Magistrates and considered the matter. On a careful consideration, the High Court finds that no specific duties should be prescribed for the Office Assistants at the residence of the Judicial Officers and directs that the Office Assistants working at the residence of the Judicial Officers have to discharge their duties allotted by the Judicial Officers.
