


ABSTRACT

Judicial Department-Earned Leave to Judicial Officers-Availing vacation as available to Teachers-Granted.

ORDER:

The Judicial Officers are working in vacation department and non vacation department. For the Judicial Officers working in non-vacation department the earned leave is calculated at the rate of 1/11 days. But the Earned Leave for Judicial Officers working in vacation department is calculated as three days per year as per rule 82 of Fundamental Rule read with TamilNadu Leave Rules 8 and 9.

2. The TamilNadu Judicial Officers' Association has requested that the Judicial Officers working in vacation department may be sanctioned 15 days of Earned Leave on per with the school teachers. The High Court has also recommended the above request.

3. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the recommendation of the High Court and direct that in the case of Judicial Officers working in the vacation side the present Earned Leave of 3 days per year be enhanced to 15 days per year if the number of working days in a year is 220 days and that proportionate deduction in the number of days of Earned Leave be made if the working days are less than 220 days in a year.

AMENDMENT

As per G.O. Ms., No., 124 (P & AR) (FR-V) Dept., dated 24.04.1995.

after Ruling (3) the following shall be added, namely:-

- 4. "Judicial Officers, working in the vacation side shall be granted 15 days Earned Leave per year, if the number of working days in a year is 220 days. If the number of working days are less than 220 days in a year, the number of days of Earned Leave shall be deducted proportionately."
- 5. This order takes effect from the calendar year 1993. Necessary amendment to the Fundamental Rules will be issued by the Government in Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department in due course.
- 6. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance and Personnel and Administrative Reforms (FR.III) Department-vide their U.O. No., 28797/FS/92, Dated 18.12.92 and U.O. No., 1609/93-1, dated 8.1.93.
