

The High Court in the Official Memorandum 1<sup>st</sup> cited, had directed all the Principal District Judges/District Judges including the Principal Judge, City Civil Court, Chennai, The Chief Judge, Puducherry and The District Judge, Karaikal, to see that no one is permitted to remain inside the Court premises for any reason whatsoever before 08.30.a.m. and after 07.00.p.m., on the Court working days across the State of Tamil Nadu and Union Territory of Puducherry.

Vide reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited the opening and closing time of Evening Courts was notified as between **06.00.p.m.** and **08.00.p.m.** 

The above contradiction in the closing time of court complexes is clarified as 08.00 p.m. instead of 07.00 p.m.
