



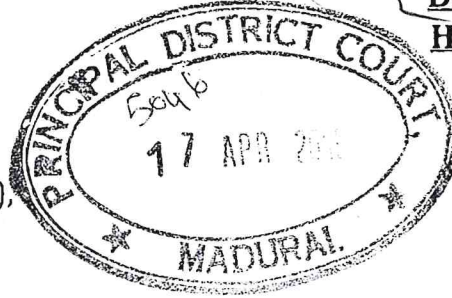

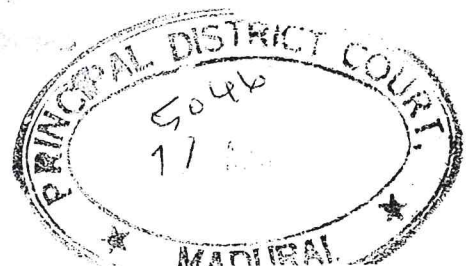

In continuation to the letter cited, I am to state that, the Hon'ble e-Committee, Supreme Court of India has informed that the disclosure of the Aadhaar number in the District Court websites, is a punishable offence under sections 37, 40 and 41 of the Aadhaar Act 2016 with the punishment being imprisonment upto 3 years.

Hence, I am to request you to instruct the staff concerned to strictly comply with the Aadhaar Act 2016, while uploading information and to remove any such information (if available) in the District Court Websites.
