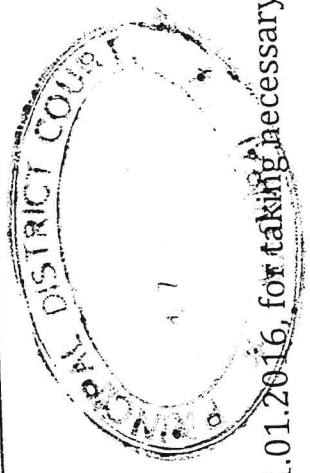

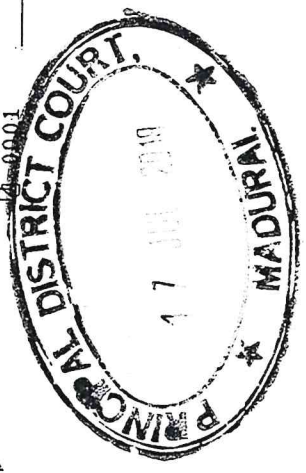

ABSTRACT

State Judicial Services - Recommendations of 2nd National Judicial Pay Commission and Orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated: 27.03.2018 - Sanction of 30% Interim relief to all Judicial Officers, Pensioners and Family Pensioners with effect from 01.01.2016 - Orders - Issued.

ORDER:-

The Government of India, in pursuance of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, had appointed the Second National Judicial Pay Commission to examine and make suitable recommendations relating to the pay structure and emoluments of Judicial Officers in the States and Union Territories, including pension and other post-retirement benefits and also to examine the work methods and work environment with a view to promoting efficiency in judicial administration. The said Judicial Pay Commission had submitted its interim report before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on 9th March, 2018. The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 643 of 2015 vide its order dated 27th March 2018, has given directions to the State Governments for implementing the Interim Relief (Pay) for Subordinate Judicial Officers as recommended by the Second National Judicial Pay Commission.

2. In compliance with the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and recommendations of High Court of Madras, the Government, after careful examination, has decided to sanction Interim Relief to Subordinate Judicial Officers as recommended by the Second National Judicial Pay Commission and as directed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its order dt.27.03.2018 and ordered that

i) Interim relief to the extent of 30% of increase in Basic pay with accrued increments shall be paid to all categories/ranks of Judicial Officers.
 ii) The said increase in pay shall be treated as a separate component and no Dearness Allowance is payable thereon.

iii) Arrears shall be worked out with effect from 01.01.2016 on the above basis.

iv) On the same basis, the benefit of Interim Relief shall be provided to the pensioners and family pensioners with effect from 01.01.2016 and arrears to be paid accordingly.

v) The Interim Relief now sanctioned shall be adjusted against pay arrears to be paid based on the recommendation of the Second National Judicial Pay Commission.

3. The Interim relief sanctioned above shall be debited to the sub-detailed head of account "5-Interim Relief" under the detailed head of account "01-Salaries" and for the Pensioners and Family Pensioner under the sub-detailed head of account "07-Interim Relief" under the detailed head of account "27-Pension".

4. Necessary additional funds will be provided in RE/FMA 2018-2019. Pending provision of such funds, the Registrar General, High Court of Madras is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in Para 2 above. However the above expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislative Assembly by Specific inclusion in Supplementary Estimate. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is also requested to send necessary draft explanatory notes to the Government in Finance (BG-I/Home-II) Department for the specific inclusion of the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates RE/FMA for the year 2018-2019 at an appropriate time without fail.

5. The Government also direct that the Interim Relief sanctioned shall be drawn and disbursed to the Judicial Officers immediately.

6. The Government also direct that the Drawing and Disbursing Officers shall be responsible to draw and disburse the Interim Arrear amount to the Judicial Officers immediately. The Drawing and Disbursing Officers shall open a separate register for making necessary entries of the Interim Arrear amount paid to Judicial Officers.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance (Home-II) Department vide its U.O.No.35159/Home-II/2018, dated 13.07.2018 with ASL No.718 (Seven Hundred and Eighteen).
