
Ref: High Court's Order in Crl.O.P.No.5922/2018, dated 19.07.2018

The Hon'ble High Court, Madras while passing interim order on 19.07.2018 in Crl.O.P.No.5922/2018, has directed the Registry to issue the following circular to all the Motor Accident Claims Tribunals, for strict compliance. Accordingly, the following instructions are issued for strict compliance.

"The Claims Tribunals shall insist upon the personal appearance of the claimant/s or their authorised representative/s with a petition to dispense with their presence, if need be, for good and valid reasons, for presenting the claim petitions at the first instance. The claimant/s shall file an affidavit at the time of such presentation that the said claim petition is the only claim petition they are filing, in respect of the accident in question and no other claim petition is filed by them in respect of the same accident and that they are aware of the truth of such statement and its implication, if it is proved to be false".

The receipt of this circular is required to be acknowledged forthwith.
