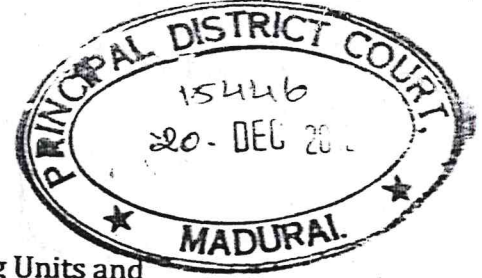

I am directed to state that the Hon'ble eCommittee, Supreme Court of India has implemented the JustIS - A Mobile Application exclusively designed for Judicial Officers in the District and Taluka Courts in the Country and informed to do the following to use the Mobile Application:

1. Download and install the APK on Android device
2. Enter (7 digit) Alpha numeric JO Code
3. It will connect to NJDG, verify the mobile number entered by High Court for the respective Judicial Officer.
4. On verification, OTP will be sent to the mobile number of Judge
5. On entering OTP and confirming Password, screen is displayed
6. Judicial Officer has to set the password.
7. On login: dashboard and everything related to the Court of that Judicial Officer will be displayed. Please explore the same.

Therefore, I am to request your goodself to inform the Judicial Officers under your control to download and use the JustIS - A Mobile Application services.
