Sub: Madras High Court at Madurai Bench – Interim Order passed in a Civil Revision case – Magistrates not to destroy the records in connection with the cases that are pending before the High Court – Registry directed to issue instructions – Circular issued – Reg.

Ref: Interim Order, dated 19.12.2018, passed in CrI.RC(MD) No.1015/2008.

The Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court, while passing interim orders, dated 19.12.2018, in CrI.RC(MD) No.1015/2008, has directed the Registry to issue instructions to all the Magistrates not to destroy the records in connection with the cases that are pending before the High Court.

As directed, all the subordinate/criminal courts in the State of Tamil Nadu and the Union Territory of Puducherry are hereby directed not to destroy the records pertaining to the cases that are pending before the High Court.

The aforesaid direction shall have to be strictly adhered to, and any deviation will be viewed seriously.
