The Government of Tamil Nadu, in consultation with the High Court of Madras, hereby designates the Principal District and Sessions Courts / District Courts in every sessions division, in the State of Tamil Nadu as Special Courts, and also appoints the Principal District and Sessions Judges/ District and Sessions Judges as the Judge of the respective Special Court, to try all the Criminal cases including Sessions cases and cases arising from (i) Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (Central Act 33 of 1989), (ii) Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act (POCSO) (Central Act 32 of 2012), (iii) exclusive trial of cases of offences against Women, (iv) Prevention of Corruption Act,1988 (Central Act 49 of 1988), (v) Communal Clash Cases Act, (vi) Bomb Blast Cases and (vii) Land Grabbing cases, as well as cases under Special Acts, Central Acts and State Acts, involving elected Members of Parliament and Members of Legislative Assembly of Tamil Nadu.
