

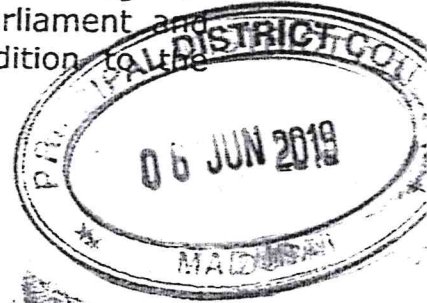

ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued for the constitution of Special Court at Chennai for trial of criminal cases related to elected Members of Parliament and Members of Legislative Assembly of Tamil Nadu. Subsequently, the above said Court was notified in the G.O. second read above and amended in G.O.third read above respectively.

2. The Registrar General, High Court, Madras in his letter 4th read above, in the circumstances stated therein, has requested to constitute of one more Special Court in Chennai in the cadre of Sessions Judge and one Additional Special Court in the cadre of Assistant Sessions Judge for trial of criminal cases related to elected Members of Parliament and Members of Legislative Assembly of Tamil Nadu in addition to the existing Special Court in Chennai.



3. The above proposal of the Registrar General, High Court, Madras has been examined by Government. After careful examination, the Government have decided to accept the proposal of the Registrar General, High Court, Madras. Accordingly, the Government hereby accord a sum of Rs.1,94,91,860/- (Rupees one crore ninety four lakh ninety one thousand eight hundred and sixty only) (Rs.1,11,48,860/- as Recurring expenditure per annum and Rs.83,43,000/- as Non-Recurring expenditure) towards creation of the following staff and other infrastructures for the Constitution of the Special Court in Chennai in the cadre of Sessions Judge and one Additional Special Court at Chennai in the cadre of Assistant Sessions Judge (senior Civil Judge cadre), for trying criminal cases related to elected Members of Parliament and Members of Legislative Assembly.
