Intances have been brought to the notice of the High Court that whenever the District Judge, Chief Judicial Magistrate or Principal Sub/Judges are directed by the High Court to enquire and submit a report on the administrative side, they themselves do not hold the enquiry, on the contrary their Subordinate Officers are directed to hold an enquiry and submit a report and they act on that report. Such an act amounts to disobedience to the directions issued by the High Court. It should be discontinued. ^{Hereafter,} the Officer directed should alone enquiry and submit a report on the basis of the enquiry.

The above instructions are issued for future guidance and strict compliance.
