ORDER :

In the G.O. third read above, the Judicial Magistrates have been permitted to claim compensatory holidays for the work done by them on holidays as per procedures laid down in G.O.Ms.No.226, Finance, Dated: 8.2.71, G.O.Ms.No.2218, Public (Misc.) Department, Dated: 14.12.81 and the procedure laid down in G.O.Ms.No.2307, Home, dt: 1.11.83 without detriment to their official duties.

2. The Registrar, High Court, Madras has reported that the Full Court of the High Court has resolved as follows:-

"If a Judicial Magistrate is permitted to avail 20 days as compensatory holidays in a year, the Court presided over by him will have to remain closed for those days in a year or another officer will have to be placed in charge, and in any event, no work will be turned out; it will cause great hardship to the litigant public and at the same time, results in the delay of disposal of cases thereby public interest suffers. Hence, it is resolved that instead of enabling the officers to have 20 days compensatory holidays in a year, the Rules may be amended to enable them to have 20 days of earned leave every year with encashment benefit, in addition to the existing earned leave and the surrender facility".

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Compensatory
Holidays

direct that the compensatory holidays earned by the Judicial Magistrates be credited in their Earned Leave account, subject to the maximum of 20 days in a year and that the overall ceiling of accumulated Earned Leave of 240 days is not exceeded on any account.
