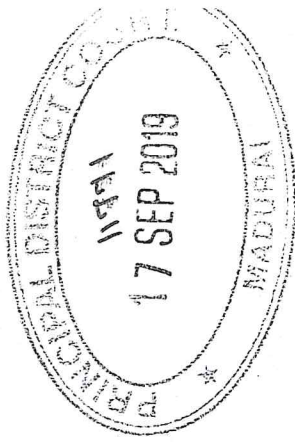
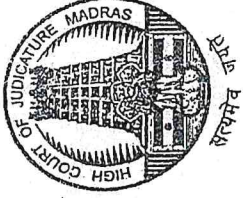

CIRCULAR

Sub: Complaints – Complaint of Corruption and Corrupt Practices against the Staff of the Judicial Department
Instructions – issued – Reg.

Ref: High Court's circular in P.Dis.No. 39/2000, dt. 28.03.2000.

Attention of the Appointing Authorities is drawn to the High Court's Circular under reference cited, wherein the Presiding Officers of the courts were informed that the petitions containing allegations of corruption against the staff of Judiciary shall be dealt with by the Appointing Authorities namely the Principal District Judge/The Additional District Judge-Cum-Chief Judicial Magistrate/The Presiding Officer of Tribunals/Special Courts, as the case may be, under intimation to the High Court and the result of the proceedings also be intimated to the High Court, Madras.

Accordingly, the complaints containing allegation of corruption received by the High Court against the staff of Subordinate Judiciary are being forwarded to the Appointing Authorities as per the instructions issued in High Court's Circular referred above.

It is further informed that as directed, the Appointing Authorities were directed to intimate the result of the proceedings initiated on the said complaints within a period of 3 months.

Now, it is noticed that the instructions issued in the High Court's circular referred to above are not followed scrupulously and result of the action taken on such complaints against staff of Subordinate Judiciary, which are forwarded by the High Court, are not being furnished within the time stipulated, despite, several reminders.

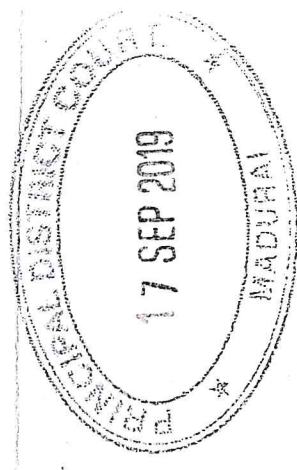
Any failure to comply with the said directions may result in appropriate action being initiated against the Judicial officer concerned for non compliance of High Court's directions.
