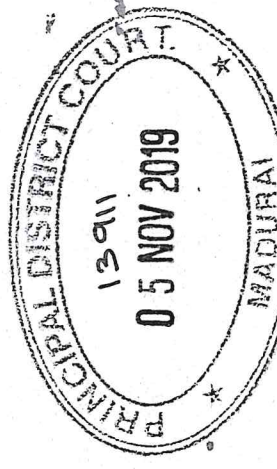

I am to state that the Government under reference eighth cited have issued orders that the [rate of Special Compensatory Allowance drawn by the Court staff deputed to the Lok Adalats on holidays on percentage basis in the revised pay structure shall be halved, i.e. from 5% to 2.5% with effect from 01.10.2017.]

In this connection I am to state that the High Court in the meeting held on 24.10.2019, have directed, that the above order of the Government shall be given a prospective effect and no recovery of excess amount, if any, paid to any staff member shall be effected on this account.

I am to further state that the Government has been addressed to suitably instruct the Accountant General/ all the Tresasury officers/PAO officers in this regard.

ABSTRACT

Compensatory Allowance - Enhancement of Compensatory Allowance to the Court staff deputed to the Lok Adalats on holidays at the rate of 2.5% of their revised basic pay with effect from 1.10.2017 - Orders - Issued.

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ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, Government accorded sanction of Compensatory Allowance to the Court staff deputed to the Lok Adalats on holidays at the rate of 5% of their basic pay with effect from 12.12.2015. The payment of the Compensatory Allowance is subject to the condition that Adalats are conducted on holidays in a respective month and if Lok Adalats are not conducted on holidays then the Compensatory Allowance shall not be claimed.

2. In the Government Order second read above, based on the recommendations of the Official Committee, 2017, orders have been issued enhancing the existing Special Pay by 50 percent and rounding it off to next 10 rupees for eligible categories as given in the Annexure to the said order and in respect of eligible employees drawing Special Pay on percentage basis, the rates of their Special Pay as percentage of pay in revised pay structure have been halved, i.e. from 20% to 10%, 15% to 7.5% and 10% to 5%. Besides, the revision of Special Pay as above shall apply only to the categories indicated in the said annexure. If there are any case of omission in the list in annexure of any category of employees presently drawing Special Pay, the Heads of Departments concerned shall send necessary proposals to Government in Finance (Allowances) Department along with the authority for inclusion in the list of the said Annexure.

3. In the Government Order third read above, based on the recommendations of the Official Committee, 2017, orders have been issued revision of rates of Allowances.

4. In the letter fourth read above, the Deputy Registrar (Admn.III), High Court, Madras has requested to issue necessary instructions to all the Treasury Officers / Pay and Accounts Officers for claiming the Compensatory

Allowance, at 5% of basic pay in the revised pay structure, who are deputed for Lok Adalat duty during holidays as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

5. After careful consideration, among the others, Government have decided to include the Court staff deputed to the Lok Adalats on holidays under the category of Special Compensatory Allowance at Sl. No: 26(a). Accordingly, Government direct that the rates of Compensatory Allowance drawn by the Court staff deputed to the Lok Adalats on holidays on percentage basis in the revised pay structure shall be halved, i.e. from 5% to 2.5%.

6. Amendments to "The Tamil Nadu Special Pay and Allowances Rules" will be issued separately.

7. These orders shall take effect from **1st October, 2017.**
