C I R C U L A R

Sub : Judicial Magistrate Courts - Assistant Public Prosecutors - making their objections - noting down in the case records - discontinuance of instructions-Issued.

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1. It has come to the notice of the High Court that the Criminal Courts are allowing the prosecutors and the Assistant Public Prosecutors to record their objection in the case records itself. Such a practice is not proper and it cannot be approved.

2. The Presiding Officers shall not allow the Assistant Public Prosecutors and Public Prosecutors to record their notice of objection in the Court records. If the Public Prosecutors and Assistant Public Prosecutors have got any objection, they shall have to file their objections separately.

3. This practice shall be followed scrupulously. Any deviation in this regard would be viewed seriously.

4. The receipt of this circular is required to be acknowledged.
