Sub: Telephones - High Court, Madras - Provision of FTTH broadband facility to the chambers and residences of the Judicial Officers in the State of Tamilnadu - Intimation - Regarding.

The Judicial Officers in all cadres, across the State, are hereby informed that the conversion of landline telephone connections at the chambers and residences into FTTH connectivity by retaining the same landline number, is approved by the Hon'ble High Court. The Judicial Officers are directed to take necessary steps in this regard and further directed to utilize either FTTH or Broadband connection under any one of the plan within the sanctioned amount.

They are further directed to disconnect the additional connections provided to their residences for Broadband / Landline / FTTH connection.

The sanctioned amount may be utilized under the Head of Account:-

"-05. Office Expenses-01 Telephone Charges".

The Judicial Officers shall report compliance of the above direction.
