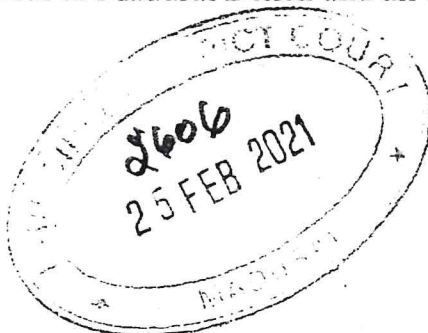

Sub: Advocates' Clerks Welfare Fund Act, 1999 – Letter received from the Secretary, Tamil Nadu Advocates Clerk Welfare Fund Committee, Bar Council of Tamil Nadu and Puducherry – Request to issue circular to all the Courts / Tribunals to affix the Tamil Nadu Advocates' Clerks Welfare Fund stamps for a value of Rs.10/- on Vakalatnama /memo of appearance – Circular issued – reg.

Ref: Letter No.TNACWF.No.93/2021, dated 13.02.2021, received from the Secretary, Tamil Nadu Advocate's Clerks Welfare Fund Committee, Bar Council of Tamil Nadu & Puducherry, received through e-mail on 15.02.2021.

In the reference cited, the Secretary, Tamil Nadu Advocates' Clerks Welfare Fund Committee, Bar Council of Tamil Nadu and Puducherry, has stated that, the Government of Tamil Nadu vide G.O.No.54 dated 01.02.2021 has enhanced the death benefit under the Tamil Nadu Advocates' Clerks Welfare Fund Act, 1999, payable to the family members of the Advocate's Clerks, who have joined as member of the Fund from R.2 lakhs to Rs.4 lakhs under Amendment of section 16 of the Tamil Nadu Advocates' Clerks Fund Act, 1999 and requested to enhance the affixation of stamps on vakalatnama / memo of appearance from Rs.2/- to 10/-.

On consideration of the matter, the High Court, Madras directs the Registry, Principal Seat & Madurai Bench and all the Subordinate Courts & Tribunals, to

affix the Advocates' Clerks Welfare Fund stamps value of Rs.10/- on vakalatnama / memo of appearance with immediate effect. The copy of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette No.54 dated 01.02.2021 is enclosed herewith.

The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Governor on the 11th December 2020 and is hereby published for general information:—

ACT No. 38 OF 2020.

An Act further to amend the Tamil Nadu Advocates' Clerks Welfare Fund Act, 1999.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Seventy-first Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Advocates' Clerks Welfare Fund (Amendment) Act, 2020. Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification, appoint.

2. In section 12 of the Tamil Nadu Advocates' Clerks Welfare Fund Act, 1999 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), in sub-section (1), for the expression "two rupees", the expression "ten rupees" shall be substituted. Amendment of section 12.

3. In section 15 of the principal Act,—

(1) in sub-section (3), for the expression "rupees one hundred", the expression "rupees five hundred" shall be substituted;

(2) in sub-section (4), for the expression "rupees one hundred", the expression "rupees five hundred" shall be substituted;

(3) in sub-section (5), for the expression "rupees two thousand", the expression "rupees five thousand" shall be substituted.

4. In section 16 of the principal Act, in sub-section (2), for the expression "rupees two lakh", the expression "rupees four lakh" shall be substituted. Amendment of section 16.
