CIRCULAR

Sub: Inclusion of "Case-Summary" in every Judgment of the Trial Courts – Instructions issued to all the Criminal Courts in Tamil Nadu and Puducherry – Reg.

Every judgment of a trial Court shall have a 'Case-Summary' which shall contain the following particulars, viz:

i. the period of remand of the accused;

ii. the date of filing of the complaint/final report in the Court;

iii. the date of committal of the case to the Court of Session;

iv. the date of questioning of the accused under Sections 228, 240, 246 and 251 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, as the case may be;

v. filing of all miscellaneous petitions and their results including the results on challenge before superior Courts; except routine petitions like petitions under Section 317 of the Code;

vi. date of examination in-chief and cross-examination of a witness;

vii. date of examination of the accused under Section 313 of the Code;

viii.

ix. details of abscondence of an accused and his appearance/production, as the case may be; and

x. grant of stay by superior Courts and the results thereof.

The Bench Clerk of the Court shall collect the above particulars and submit the same to the Presiding Officer before the Judgment is pronounced.

The above instructions shall be followed from 01.05.2021.
