It has been brought to the notice of the High Court
by the Director General of Police, Admiralty House, Government
Estate, Madras 2, that the Disposal of Arms, Ammunitions, Bombs
and other explosive materials, instead of destroying those case
properties, can be utilized for demonstration purpose for the
officers and various personnel of police department.

The said request of the Director General of Police was
considered by the Full Court of the Honourable High Court and
resolved as follows :-

It is Resolved that whenever it is decided by the courts that
the arms and ammunition involved in the cases are to be
destroyed, instead of directing destruction of the same, a
direction be issued to hand over the same to the Director
General of Police to be used for the purpose mentioned in
his letter dated 4.12.'95 in G.No.767/160546/Gr.II(S)/95.
A copy of the said letter shall also be communicated to all
the courts.
