CIRCULAR

Sub: High Court, Madras – Directions to the Subordinate Criminal Courts regarding taking on file of final reports and issuing acknowledgments – Issued.

All the Judicial Magistrates in the State of Tamil Nadu and U.T. of Puducherry are hereby directed to take the final reports filed by the Police concerned on file without returning the same and all the Principal District Judges/Chief Judicial Magistrates shall ensure that the final reports in criminal cases are not returned for any reason. Further, all the Judicial Magistrates are directed to give proper acknowledgment to the Police concerned on filing final reports.

All the Principal District Judges/Principal Judge/District Judges/Chief Judge are directed to send monthly reports of those cases where final reports are not filed in the Courts within statutory time to the High Court, with a copy marked to the Commissioner of Police/Superintendent of Police of the District Concerned.

All the Principal District Judges are instructed to discuss the pending final reports as one of the subjects in the Monitoring Committee meeting with the Police officials.

The aforesaid instructions/directions are to be followed scrupulously and any violation will be viewed seriously.
