Government of India have set up a Task Force to go into the rules and procedure relating to financial transactions and how best they could be simplified and rationalised for ensuring timely compilation. This Committee will also be going into various aspects of computarication as a part of improving the system of compilation of accounts.

In Tamil Nadu, timely compilation of precise accounts has been given very great importance and from time to time, Government have been issuing series of Instructions to Heads of Depart ents, to the Treasuries, etc. (vide the reference vited Government have also appointed an Inspection Cell in Finance Department to go round the offices of Heads of Departments study and match the progress of reconciliation. Sovern ment, however, feel to t there is score for improvement in the matter of timeliness and precision of compilation of account It has therefore, been decided to annoint a Committee, under a senior officer, to go into various aspects for improving the system further with the following mombers:

The Committee shall submit its report in the first phase on the following .oints:-

- ,1, seview the present system of compilation and reconciliation of treasry accounts and suggest imm improvements.
- (2) Improvements to Treasures .. Sub Treasuries in the matter of staff norms, accommodation, mechanical aids etc. so that they can function with greater efficiency and provide greates service to the public.

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- (3) haview the codification of heads of improve compilation and reconciliation in the Data Centre.
- (4) The procedure for Account Compilation in the case of chaque drawing departments in general, with particular reference to Public Divisions may be gone into.
- (5) Study the need for changeover in the Pay and Accounts Offices to the Treasury system of compilation.

In the second phase, the Committee is requested to go into aspects of Management Accounting, with reference to current budget procedure and schedule and the pe formance Budgets being prepared in select Departments, and how they can be intograted effectively with information system available from the Data Centre.

The Committee is requested to furnish its report on the terms of reference mentioned in para 2 within 6 wooks.

The Committee may undertake necessary tours for the purpose of preparing its report.
