side and not on the administrative side – Instructions issued
– Communicated.

Further, it is noticed that if they could not decide the cases within the said time frame, the request for extension of time to decide the matter has been made on the administrative side.

In view of the above, as ordered, all the Judicial Officers of the trial courts/ District Courts are hereby instructed that whenever direction given on Judicial side to decide the cases in a time bound manner it has to be followed by them and if they could not decide the matter within the said time frame, they have to seek extension of time to decide the matter only on the Judicial side and not on the administrative side.

All the Judicial Officers of the trial courts / District Courts are further informed to follow the aforesaid instructions without any deviation.
