Sub: Courts and Judges - Code of Conduct for the Judicial Officers in the Tamil Nadu State Judicial Service and Puducherry Judicial Service - Certain directions issued.

All the Judicial Officers in the State of Tamil Nadu and Union Territory of Puducherry are henceforth informed that they may submit a complaint only through the District Judge concerned to the High Court, Madras, whenever they experience any occupational inconvenience in the form of Law officer appointed through Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission, while discharging their official duties.

The above directions shall be followed scrupulously without any deviation.
