



## P.DIS.No. 39 /2000 CIRCULAR

Dentbyou sub: Complaints - Complaint of Corruption

and corrupt Practices against the Staff of the Judicial Department - . Investigation - Revised instructions -Orders - Issued - Regarding.

The Presiding Officers of courts are informed that all petitions containing allegations of corruption or corrupt practices against the members of the staff should be dealt with by the Appointing Authorities namely the Principal District Judge/the Additional District Judge-cum-Chief Judicial Magistrate/the Presiding Officer of Tribunals/Special Courts, as the case may be, under intimation to the High Court and the result of the proceedings also be intimated to the High Court, Madras.

The instructions issued in High Court's Circular in P.Dis, No. 466/69, dated 10.11.1969 are hereby modified to the extent as stated above.
