Sub: Treasuries and Accounts--Payment for a month in which leave is taken and not regularized--clarifications--issued.

The Treasuries and Accounts Modernisation Committee recommended that in the case of regular Government servants who are going on leave during the course of the month, the pay for the entire month be paid pending regularisation of leave and the differences in pay, if any, may be adjusted in the subsequent month or any other dues to Government servants, as the case may be. The Government have accepted the above recommendation and issued orders accordingly in the G.O. first cited.

2.The Accountant General, Tamil Nadu, in his letter second cited has requested to clarify whether the term 'leave' includes all kinds of leave including half-pay leave and extraordinary leave and whether pay will be paid in full only in case where the nature of leave to be granted is not known or decided and the leave itself is pending sanction and whether the pay for the full month is to be paid only for the first month during the course of which the Government servant goes on leave and not for any subsequent month/months.

3.The Government in consultation of the Director of Treasuries and Accounts, Madras direct that--

i. the term 'leave' includes all kinds of leave including half-pay leave;

ii. the pay will be paid in full pending sanction of the leave, there is no need to know about the nature of the leave to be granted and

iii. the full salary is to be paid for the first month in which the leave is taken and not for any subsequent period.
