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I am to invite a reference to the High Court
letters cited wherein the Additional District Judges-cum-Chief
Judicial Magistrates in District level and Judicial Magistrates
in the taluk level are directed that they should inspect
the Police Lock-ups in their respective Jurisdiction at least
once in a month, independently, and submit their report to
the High Court. Some of the District Judges-cum-Chief
Judicial Magistrates have not submitted their Inspection Report
to the High Court periodically and it causes much inconvenience
to the Office of the Registry.

Therefore, all the Presiding Officers are
required to submit their inspection report periodically
to this Registry.
