ORDER

As per rule 15-D of General Provident fund (Tamil Nadu) Rules (as corrected upto 31.8.1990) the Part-final withdrawal shall be allowed to the Government employees for the purchase of Motor Car whose pay is Rs.1,000/- per mensem or more. Further the amount shall be limited to Rs.16,000/- or one-third of the amount standing to the credit of the subscriber in the fund or the actual price of the car whichever is the least. However in special cases, the sanctioning authority may sanction the withdrawal upto one-half of the balance at subscriber's credit in the fund account, if considered necessary. Under the rule 15-E of the said Rules, the amount of withdrawal to be sanctioned to a subscriber, whose pay is Rs.1,100/- per mensem or more, for repairing or overhauling the Motor Car and the amount should be limited to Rs.5,000/- or one-third of the amount standing to the credit of the subscriber in the fund account or the actual cost of repairing/overhauling whichever is the least.

2. The Registrar General, High Court, Chennai in his letter read above has raised some clarifications regarding the existing rules position for drawal of part-final withdrawal by the Government Employees for purchasing a Motor Car and for overhauling Motor Car under rules 15-D and 15-E of General Provident fund (Tamil Nadu) Rules respectively. Since the eligibility criteria and the amount mentioned in the said rules were prescribed prior to 1984, he has requested to issue clarification in this matter.

3. The Government after careful examination, have decided to revise the limit prescribed in Rule 15(D) and Rule 15(E) of General Provident Fund Rules. They accordingly direct that the limit prescribed in Rule 15(D) and Rule 15(E) of General Provident Fund rules as below:

Rule 15(D) of General Provident Fund Rules for withdrawal from the Fund for the purchase of motor car

<u>Existing Provision.</u>	<u>Revised Provision.</u>
(1) The Officers pay shall be Rs.1,000/- p.m. or more.	(1) The Officers pay scale shall be Rs.10,000-15200 and above.
(2) The amount of withdrawal shall be limited to Rs.16,000/- or one-third of the amount standing to the credit of the subscriber in the fund or the actual price of the car whichever is least.	(2) The amount of withdrawal shall be limited to Rs.1.00 lakh or one-third of the amount standing to the credit of the subscriber or the actual cost of the car whichever is least.

Rule 15(E) of General Provident Fund Rules for withdrawal from Fund for REPAIRS or OVERHAULING.

<u>Existing Provision</u>	<u>Revised Provision.</u>
(1) The Officers pay is Rs.1,100/- p.m. or more.	(1) The Officers pay scale shall be Rs.10000/- 15200 and above.
(2) The amount of withdrawal shall be limited to Rs.5,000/- or one-third of the amount standing to the credit of the subscriber, or the actual amount of repairing, overhauling whichever is least.	(2) The amount of withdrawal shall be limited to Rs.20,000 or one-third of the amount standing to the credit of the subscriber or the actual amount of repairing, overhauling whichever is least.

4. Necessary amendments to the General Provident Fund (Tamil Nadu) Rules will be issued separately.

5. These orders shall take with immediate effect.
