ORDER:

The Treasury and Accounts Modernisation Committee recommended that in the case of regular Government servants who are going on leave during the course of the month, the pay for the entire month be paid pending regularization of leave and the differences in pay, if any, may be adjusted in the subsequent month or any other amount due to Government servants, as the case may be. The Government has accepted this recommendation and issued orders accordingly in a G.O. first read above. In the memo second read above, it has been clarified that the term "leave" will include all kinds of leave including leave on half pay that the pay will be paid in full pending sanction of the leave; that there is no need to know the nature of the leave to be granted and that full salary is to be paid for the first month in which the leave is taken and not for any subsequent period. In the G.O. third read above it has been further clarified that these orders do not cover cases of unauthorized absence.

2. These orders were not made applicable to the self-drawing officers for whom pay slips are issued by the Accountant General and the Pay and Accounts Officers. The Accountant General, Tamil Nadu in his letter fourth read above has informed that there is no objection to extending the above concession to all self-drawing officers in the state, in whose case pay slips are issued by his office and that all Treasury Officers may be instructed accordingly. The Director of Treasuries and Accounts has also agreed with the Accountant General's views.

3. The Government accept the suggestion of the Accountant General, Tamilnadu and direct that these orders be extended to all

self-drawing officers including All India Service Officers also in whose case, pay slips are issued by the Accountant General I and II, Madras/the Pay and Accounts Officee, Madras. The Treasury Officers/Pay and Accounts Officers are requested to allow the self-drawing officers to draw full salary for the first month during which they proceed on leave subject to the conditions imposed in the references second and third read above.
