OFFICIAL MEMERANDUM

Sub: Constitution of Board of Visitors to visit Police Lock-ups - Instructions already issued - belated submission of reports - Fresh instructions issuing of - Reg.

Read: 1. Circular P.Dis.77 of 96 dated 14.6.96.
2. Circular in ROC.No.1342/99/F1, dated 24.8.99.

The High Court, vide circulars cited, had issued necessary instructions to all the erstwhile Addl. District Judge -cum- Chief Judicial Magistrates regarding the procedures to be followed pertaining to the visit of police lock-up and submission of monthly report(s) thereof by the respective Chief Judicial Magistrates along with their reports of Judicial Magistrates/ Metropolitan Magistrates as the case may be following in their respective units.

It is seen that most of the reports are being submitted to the High Court belatedly and at times after a lapse of 2 months period. Such belated reports not only cause inconvenience to the Hon'ble High Court to pass appropriate orders but also defeat the very purpose of the lock up visit by the Judicial Officers.

All the Chief Judicial Magistrates including the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Madras are directed to issue suitable instructions to all the Judicial Magistrates / Metropolitan Magistrates following under their unit immediately in this regard and see that the reports of the Judicial Magistrates/Metropolitan Magistrates are obtained and submitted

along with their respective report, to the High Court on
or before the 10th day of the following month.

These instructions are to be followed
scrupulously and any diviation would be viewed seriously.

The receipt of the Official Memorandum is to
be acknowledged at once.
